

ESH Specialist: Sr. ESH Specialist

Interprets, recommends, and complies with environmental, health and safety regulations and/or company policies. Assists in planning for changes in physical facilities to meet new environmental requirements. Finds, evaluates, and prepares contracts for properly licensed hazardous waste disposal firms and monitors waste handling. Organizes and equips spill-control teams. Writes and updates environmental and spill-control manuals and procedures. Prepares environmental impact statements and applies for all new permits and renewals. Provides input to federal and state regulators through trade associations and industry groups for the writing and revision of regulations.

Knowledge

Applies extensive technical expertise, and has full knowledge of other related disciplines.

Problem Solving

Develops technical solutions to complex problems which require the regular use of ingenuity and creativity.

Discretion/Latitude

Work is performed without appreciable direction. Exercises considerable latitude in determining technical objectives of assignment. Completed work is reviewed from a relatively long-term perspective, for desired results.

Impact

Guides the successful completion of major ESH programs and may function in a project leadership role. Erroneous decisions or recommendations would typically result in failure to achieve major compliance or project objectives and might result in fines or additional regulatory oversight.

Liaison

Represents the organization as the prime ESH contact. Interacts with external regulatory personnel on significant technical matters often requiring coordination between organizations.
