Coats surface of parts, assemblies and finished products with protective or decorative materials such as paint, varnish, enamel, lacquer, dope or stain using spray gun. Selects and mixes coating material; coats areas inaccessible to hand sprayer using brush or roller. May monitor and verify quality in accordance with statistical process or other control procedures.

Knowledge

Full knowledge of the job. Substantial acquaintance with, and understanding of, general aspects of the job with a broad understanding of the detailed aspects of the job.

Supervision Received

General supervision and instructions given for routine work and detailed instructions given for new activities or special assignments.

Consequence of Errors

Errors may be detected and corrected but may cause moderate loss of time or customer/user dissatisfaction.

Contacts

Contacts are typically with individuals within own department and occasionally with contacts outside own organization. Contacts involve obtaining or providing information or data requiring some explanation or interpretation.

Work Products (Examples may include but are not limited to)

Perform non-complex operations to normal tolerances and quality requirements. Operate applicable equipment and/or perform manual operations to productive capacity. Assist higher level workers. Work with various equipment to perform functions; finishing, mask, sand, prep, fill, touch-up and peen blasting. Ability to follow verbal instructions, operation sheets, sketches, prints or samples.

Minimum Education and Experience

High School Diploma or equivalent, plus 1-4 years of experience.
