

## Finisher: Finisher III

---

Coats surface of parts, assemblies and finished products with protective or decorative materials such as paint, varnish, enamel, lacquer, dope or stain using spray gun. Selects and mixes coating material; coats areas inaccessible to hand sprayer using brush or roller. May monitor and verify quality in accordance with statistical process or other control procedures.

### **Knowledge**

Considerable knowledge of the job. Complete acquaintance with, and understanding of, the general and detailed aspects of the job, and their practical applications to problems and situations ordinarily encountered.

### **Supervision Received**

Limited supervision. No instructions needed on routine work and general instructions given on new lines of work or special assignments.

### **Consequence of Errors**

Errors may be difficult to detect and would normally result in loss of customer business, material or equipment.

### **Contacts**

Contacts are frequent with individuals representing other departments, and/or representing outside organizations. Contacts involve obtaining or providing information or data on matters of moderate importance to the function of the department or which may be of sensitive nature.

### **Work Products (Examples may include but are not limited to)**

Perform semi-complex operations to normal tolerances and quality requirements. Set up and operate applicable equipment and/or perform manual operations to productive capacity. Record and maintain data as required. Work with various equipment to perform functions; cleaning, mechanical finishing, marking, painting (brush), stencil fabrication and silk screen fabrication. Ability to read blueprints and operation sheets.

### **Minimum Education and Experience**

High School Diploma or equivalent, plus 4-8 years of experience.
